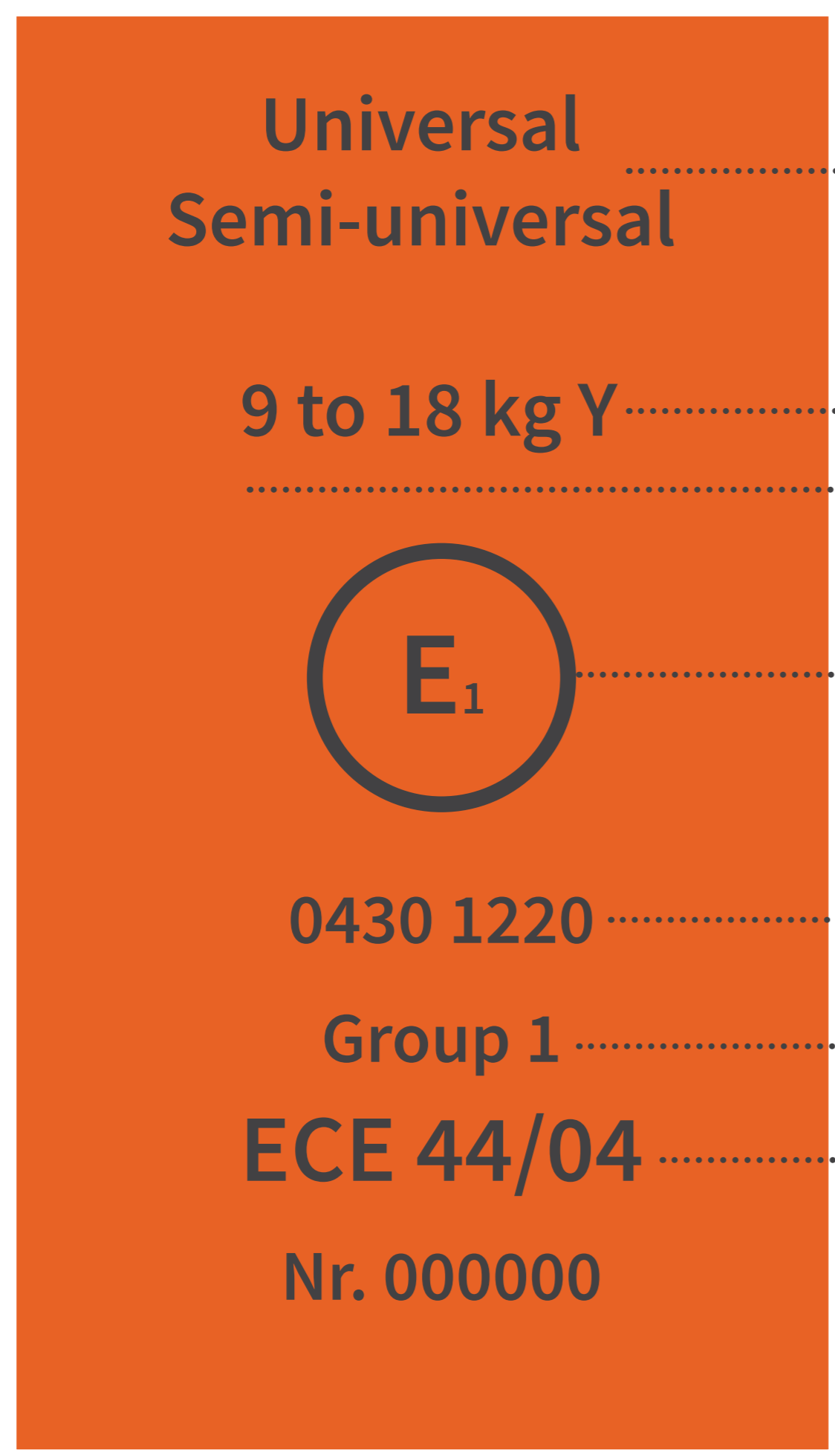


ECE Label Explained



Type of approval:

- Universal - can be used in vehicles with 3 point seatbelts
- Semi-universal - approved vehicles can be found in the vehicle type list

Y - Indicates harnessed seat

Body weight range - Suitable for children from 9 till 18kg

International approval symbol with code for the country in which it was registered:

- 1 = Germany
- 2 = France
- 3 = Italy ...

Approval number - the first 2 numbers indicate which version the child seat is approved under

ECE Group - weight class of the seat

European child seat testing standard version R 44/04

South Africa is a signatory to the child restraint regulations as set out by the European Economic Community. This is commonly referred to as ECE 44 and Regulation 129. These regulations set minimum standards for every aspect of child restraints and the manufacture thereof. A child restraint with ECE certification assures us that the child restraint is safe and legally acceptable for use.

Child restraints or car seats that has passed the scrutiny of the regulations will have an orange sticker placed on it in a clearly visible location, usually at the back of the car seat.

This sticker serves as an “ID Document” of the seat
